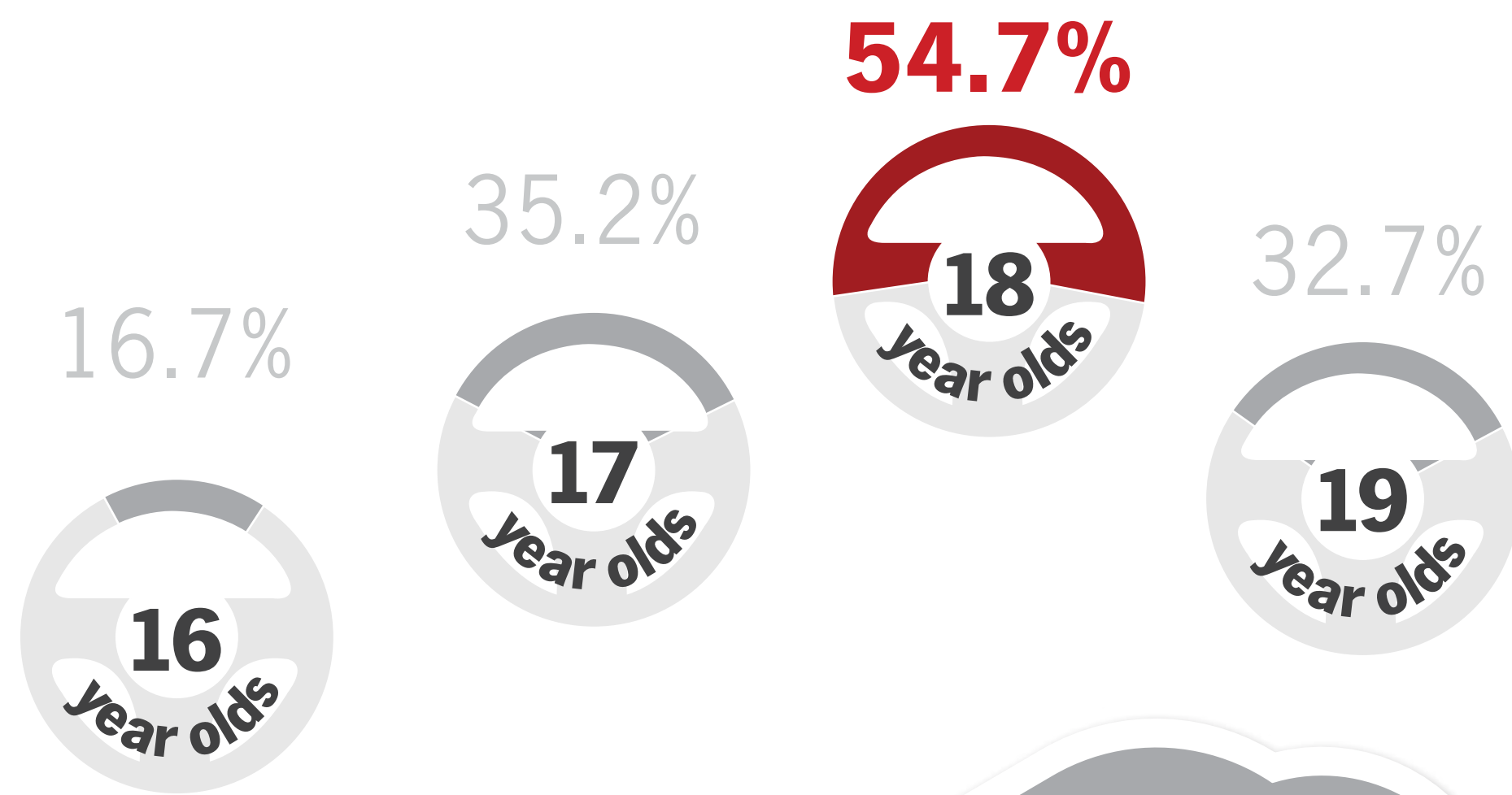


Teen Drug Impaired Driving:

A PROBLEM THAT
CAN'T BE IGNORED

PRESENCE OF DRUGS HIGHEST AMONG FATALLY INJURED 18 YEAR OLD DRIVERS



MORE DRUGS THAN ALCOHOL

Of those drivers fatally injured between 16-19 years of age:

2000

40.3% tested positive for **alcohol**
23.6% tested positive for **drugs**



2010

36.6% tested positive for **alcohol**
39.2% tested positive for **drugs**



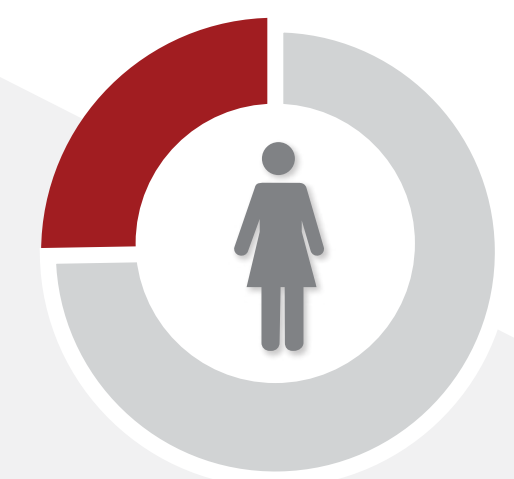
MALES ARE MORE AT RISK

Among drivers aged 16-19 who were fatally injured,

43% of males tested positive for drugs

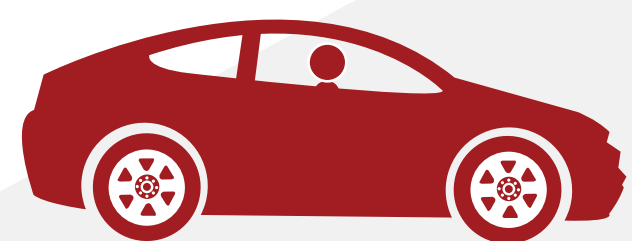


25.4% of females tested positive for drugs



CANNABIS IS USED MOST

From 2008 to 2010, 245 fatally injured drivers 16-19 years old were tested for drugs. Of those,



28.6% tested positive for **cannabis**



4.1% tested positive for **ecstasy**



3.7% tested positive for **cocaine**

Other drugs accounted for 11.4%.
