BE INFORMED, STAY SAFE, AND MAKE EVERY CHOICE COUNT

FEWER TEEN DRIVERS ARE FATALLY INJURED IN ROAD CRASHES COMPARED TO A DECADE AGO, BUT TEENS ARE STILL MORE LIKELY TO BE KILLED IN ROAD CRASHES THAN ANY OTHER AGE GROUP AND ROAD CRASHES ARE THE LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH AMONG PERSONS UNDER 24 YEARS OF AGE.
