


DID YOU KNOW.....

Canadian drivers of large trucks were much less likely to be considered "at-fault" in fatal crashes than drivers of other vehicles according to a Canadian at-fault analysis.




90% OF ALL CONSUMER GOODS ARE DELIVERED BY DRIVERS OF LARGE TRUCKS.

Drivers of large trucks need more space on the road because:

THEY HAVE LARGER BLIND SPOTS





Driving too close

means they can't

see you.

THEY NEED MORE DISTANCE TO STOP



Leave 3 to 4 car lengths before merging in front of a large truck.

THEY MAKE MUCH WIDER TURNS



At intersections leave enough space and stay back for large trucks to pull to the outside of their lane to make a wide turn.

Cyclists should avoid travelling or stopping at an intersection beside a large truck.
