




## DID YOU KNOW.....

Canadian drivers of large trucks were much less likely to be considered "at-fault" in fatal crashes than drivers of other vehicles according to a Canadian at-fault analysis.





## DID YOU KNOW.....


Drivers of large trucks need more space on the road because:

**THEY HAVE LARGER BLIND SPOTS**




**ROAD SAFETY TIPS** ✓ Keep your distance from large trucks. Driving too close means they can't see you.

**THEY NEED MORE DISTANCE TO STOP**



**ROAD SAFETY TIPS** ✓ Leave 3 to 4 car lengths before merging in front of a large truck.

**THEY MAKE MUCH WIDER TURNS**



**ROAD SAFETY TIPS** ✓ At intersections leave enough space and stay back for large trucks to pull to the outside of their lane to make a wide turn.



**Cyclists should avoid travelling or stopping at an intersection beside a large truck.**
